Father for providing Jesus



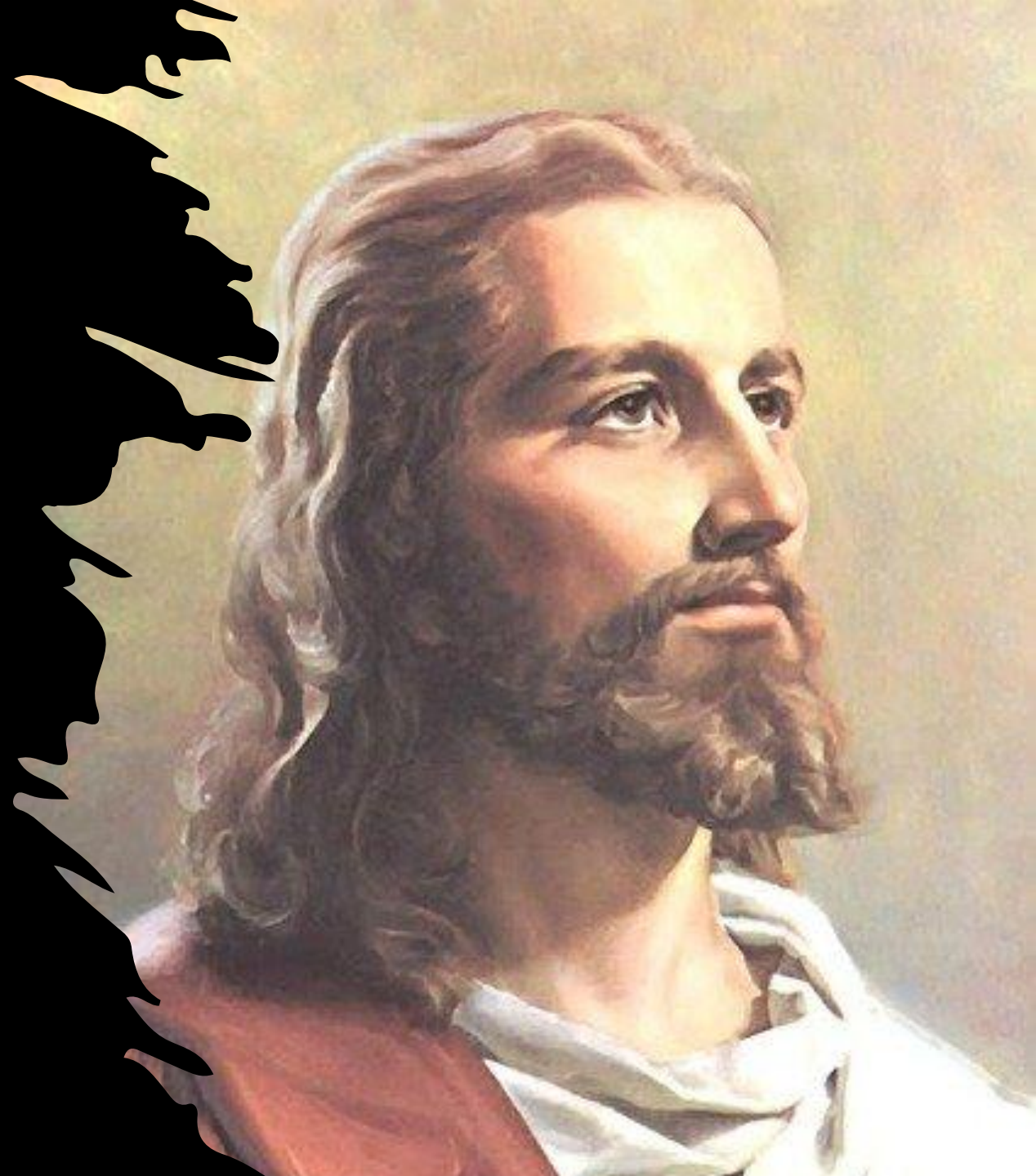
Isa 9:6 the government shall be upon his

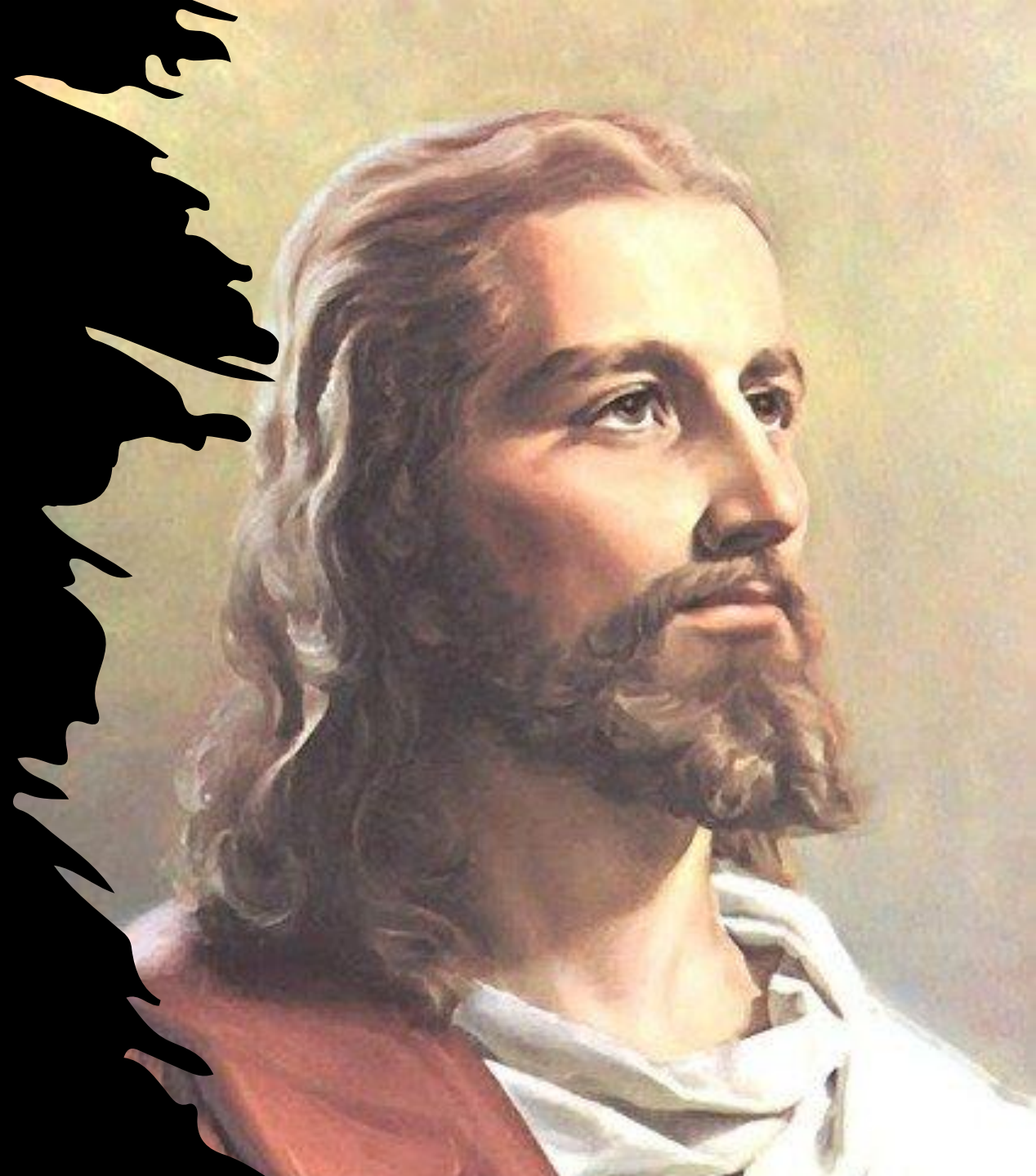

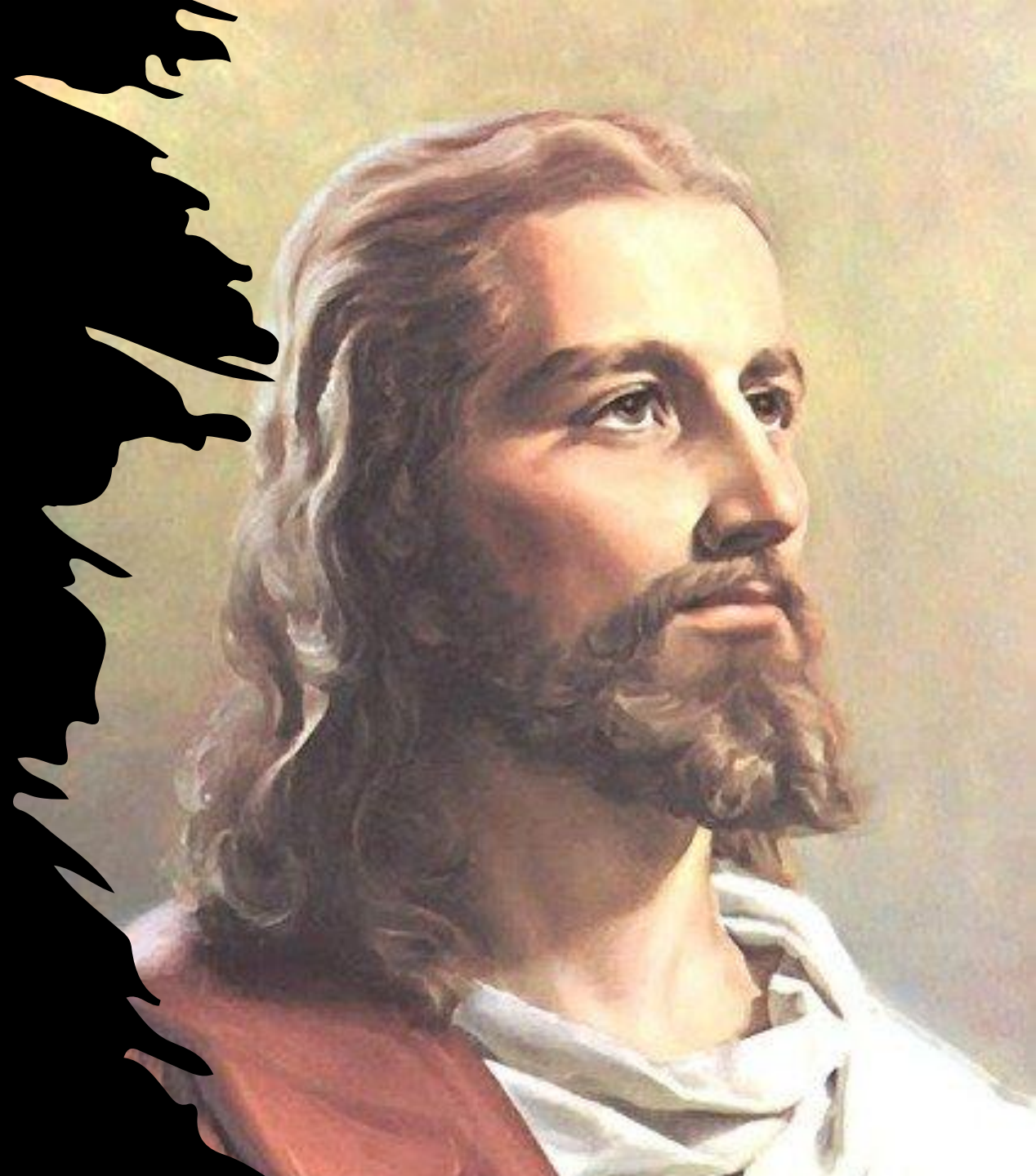


